GENERAL RULES & CONDITIONS

Please Read Carefully

The East Coast Arabian Championships are conducted under the rules of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Limited (AHSA), together with the rules and definitions printed in this Schedule. Copies of the AHSA Rule Book are available from the Secretary.

Closing date of entries: The closing date for entries is **Friday 3rd December 2010**. Entries must be postmarked by this date or will not be accepted. Refund of entries will not be made under any circumstances after the closing date of entries.

Reduced entry fees: Reduced entry fees will apply to **2011 Financial Members** of the NSW Arabian Horse Association Inc. only (**not** the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd). If you are not a financial member of the Association for 2011, you can join or renew with your entries provided you include the appropriate membership fees and application form.

Special Youth Package (Members Only): \$120.00 (Unlimited entry into Youth Classes 124 - 129, 136, 138, 140, 142 & 144. This is per horse/competitor combination)

Stabling of Exhibits: The cost of stabling will be as follows (**GST Inclusive**): **Stable Fee** \$22.00 per day (or part thereof); **Bedding: Shavings** \$12.00 per bag; **Stable Bond** of \$75.00 payable on each stable, which is refundable when the stable is inspected and found to be completely empty. Stabling days are worked out as starting from 5pm the night before i.e. if you need a stable for Thursday & Friday the starting time is 5pm on Wednesday night until 5pm on Friday night. Please note straw will not be provided though if competitors prefer to have straw they are welcome to arrange delivery themselves.

Presentation Night Stabling – Stables for Saturday evening can be booked on your entry form or with the Stable Monitor at the show on Thursday or Friday **ONLY, not Saturday morning**. All stable bookings made at the show will need to be paid for at the office and proof of payment produced to the Stable Monitor before your stable will be unlocked. Any horse found in a stable that has not been paid for on Saturday will be removed and the stable will be locked until proof of payment has been produced.

Day Parking Fee: There is a day parking fee for those competitors working out of their floats at a cost of \$10.00 per day (GST Inclusive). Day parking will be in the North Truck area, and toilets are available in this area. **Unless you intend to leave your horse/s at the showground overnight, please elect to day park**

rather than request a stable. This will ensure those travelling distances will have adequate stabling available.

Camping: There are 2 types of accommodation available at Horsley Park:- **Powered Camp Sites** (for tents, caravans, floats or trucks – supplied by the exhibitor) at \$25.00 per night or the **Demountable Cabins** at \$40.00 per night (prices include GST). Bookings must be made on entries and accompanied by full payment. No phone bookings will be taken.

Pending Registrations: All horses entered MUST be registered with the Arabian Horse Society of Australia with correct registration numbers available at the closing date of entries. All horses entered without registration numbers MUST provide these registration numbers prior to the printing of the catalogue. Failure to comply will make the horse ineligible to compete. Pending registrations at the close of cataloguing will NOT be accepted and no refund of entries will be given for such horses.

Timetable of Events: The Timetable will be available for downloading from the Association website (www.nswarabian.org.au) approximately 2 weeks prior to the commencement of the show. Exhibitors will be notified by mail of the timetable of events and the allocation of stables (where possible), approximately 2 weeks before the show. The starting times in the timetable are final and will only be changed if a ring is running late. No class will start ahead of the advised time. EVERY EFFORT WILL BE MADE TO RUN THE CLASSES AS ADVISED IN THE SCHEDULE. IN THE EVENT OF ENTRIES EXCEEDING PREVIOUS YEAR'S NUMBERS, SOME EVENTS MAY NEED TO BE MOVED TO ANOTHER DAY TO ACCOMMODATE NUMBER OF ENTRIES. YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED IF THIS IS THE CASE.

Show Office: This office will be open during the following times:
Wednesday: 1pm to 5pm
Thursday & Friday: 7am to 12pm and 2pm to 5pm
Saturday: 10am to 12pm

Exhibit Numbers: A charge of \$2.00 per exhibit number (GST Inclusive) must be paid with entry fees. Numbers to be collected from the show office during the hours listed above. EXHIBITORS NOT WEARING THE CORRECT EXHIBIT NUMBER AS PER THE CATALOGUE WILL NOT BE JUDGED.

Committee Accepts No Responsibility: It is the policy of the Committee to see that all due care is taken to protect property but the Committee shall not be liable to any person in case of loss or damage by reason of any defect, accident, negligence or neglect, however arising.

Cheque & other negotiable instruments: Any cheque or negotiable instrument received or accepted by the Committee shall be deemed to have been received as a conditional payment only and subject to payment upon presentation. Any exhibitor who has had cheques unpaid upon presentation, or who has defaulted on any payment, is on a STRICTLY CASH ONLY BASIS for twelve months from the date of the above-mentioned occurrence. **Bounced cheques and declined credit cards will incur a \$10 admin charge plus bank fees.**

NB: PLEASE KEEP A RECORD OF ENTRIES LODGED, AS TELEPHONE ENQUIRIES REGARDING THIS MATTER ARE TIME CONSUMING. THE COMMITTEE SUGGESTS THAT ENTRIES BE SENT BY REGISTERED MAIL OR EXPRESS POST THAT IS TRACKABLE, IF WORRIED THAT ENTRIES COULD GO ASTRAY IN THE MAIL.

Awards: All Classes will be awarded Champion, Reserve Champion and 3 x Top 5 equal placings, regardless of number of entries received.

Dividing or Combining of Classes: Should entries warrant, classes may be divided according to height, gender or date of birth, at the committee's discretion. At the closing date of entries should numbers in classes be insufficient, classes may be combined at the committee's discretion. In the case of a Performance Class no more than 12 horses will be on the circle at any one time.

Exhibitors Please Note: No exhibitors will be permitted to enter the ring once the Marshall has closed the ring (handed the ring card over to the steward).

Young Horse Saddle Classes are open to horses 3 & 4 years of age **ONLY** and must be ridden in a snaffle bit. 4-year-old horses entered in this class are **NOT** eligible for entry into the East Coast Cups. **Maximum of 3 horse/rider combinations, however all horses must have a suitably attired and capable rider. No horses are to be presented before the judge unmounted.**

Open Saddle Horse Championships are classes for horses 4 years & over.

East Coast Cup Saddle Awards are for horses 4 years and over. Horses to be presented and ridden as Open Hacks ie. English riding attire, including gloves, Weymouth Bridles (no pelham or rugby pelham bits), plaits (no running plaits) and English Saddle essential. Hacking canes and spurs optional, no dressage whips permitted. Please note, horses entered in the Young Horse Saddle Classes are ineligible to compete in this event. **Maximum of 3 horse/rider combinations, however all horses must have a suitably attired and capable rider. No horses are to be presented before the judge unmounted.**

Bridle Path Hacks To be judged 80% performance and manners and 20% condition and conformation. Horses will be judged at the walk, trot and canter in both directions on the ring. The judge may ask for extensions. There are no individual workouts. All English bits eligible, hacking canes with or without flapper. Refer Rule 23.2 of the AHSA 2007 Rule Book.

Costume AHSA Ltd Rules apply as per rule 26 of the AHSA 2007 Rule Book. To be judged 50% for costume and 50% horse's manners and paces. Trappings must not hang below the knees or hocks of the horse. All youth competitors in costume **MUST** wear approved safety helmets and boots with their costumes.

Show Hunter Classes Horses competing in this section may also compete in other sections of the show. To be judged according to Rule 23.3 of the AHSA 2007 Rule Book. Dummy spurs permitted. A whip or cane (with or without flapper) maximum length not to exceed 75cm (30 inches) also permitted. Dressage whips are not permitted. Browbands must be unadorned.

Sidesaddle Must be ridden by a lady or girl in full habit. All youth competitors **MUST** wear approved safety helmet.

Western Pleasure To be judged 70% on performance & manners, 30% on conformation, quality and presentation. Horses will be shown both ways on the ring at the walk, jog & lope on a reasonably loose rein. Individual workouts are not required.

Harness To be judged according to Rule 25 of the AHSA 2007 Rule Book.

Working Stockhorse To be judged 80% pattern work and 20% ability of rider and appointments as per rule 28.2 AHSA 2007 Rule Book. Competitors will perform the workout as per rule 28.2 of the AHSA 2007 Rule Book.

Amateur Owner Classes Horses and Ponies are to be ridden and led by an amateur owner. **Owner** means the person who is noted in the records of the Arabian Horse Society as the Owner or Lessee of the Horse or Pony, or a member of their immediate family. **Amateur** means regardless of one's equestrian skills and or accomplishments, a person is considered an amateur who does not either ride, drive, handle or train or assist in the riding, driving, handling, training of horses/ponies for remuneration. The exhibitor **MUST** provide with their entries a copy of their current Amateur Owner Card issued and as required by the AHSA and in accordance with Rule 16 per the 2007 AHSA Rule Book.

Classic/Best Head & Trot Classes: Winners of Classic/Best Head & Trot classes are not eligible for their respective age Championships.

Colts/Stallions: No Colt or Stallion is permitted to be handled/ridden/driven by persons under 17 years of age.

Swabbing: Random Swabbing of exhibits will be carried out during the show. Failure to report straight to the swabbing box will result in being stripped of your award and possible disciplinary action.

Presentation Night Tickets: Admission tickets for the Presentation Night may be purchased either on your entry form, from the show office and/or the front gate on Saturday evening. Cost per ticket is **\$15.00** for Adults or **\$10.00** for Children 5 – 12 years (GST inclusive). Exhibitors may book and pay for tickets on their entry form at a reduced cost of **\$10.00** per adult ticket and **\$5.00** per child ticket (GST inclusive). **Please note – there will NOT be any free exhibitors' passes available.** **Anyone entering the grounds from Saturday morning will be required to show finals night tickets or purchase one at the gate.**

Conduct of Exhibitors: No exhibitor may leave the judging area until directed by the ring stewards. Use of noise making devices, ie rattles, in the marshalling area are not permitted. Excessive use of whips will not be tolerated. Lunging of horses in the marshalling area or on entry into the ring is not permitted. Marshals and stewards may issue a warning to any exhibitor infringing the rules. The exhibit number of any exhibitor so warned will be recorded by the steward on the back of the ring card for the class in which the exhibit is competing or about to compete. The Ring Supervisor will be advised of any warning issued. If a second warning is issued the exhibitor may be disqualified at the discretion of the Ring Supervisor. Further action including a ban on competing in a future year may be considered by the committee after the show. Any person found setting off fire alarm or tampering with fire hoses/hydrants will be liable for a fine of \$1,000.00.

Professional Handlers, Trainers & Riders Please Note: Entry forms filled out for client horses MUST be accompanied by a letter SIGNED BY THE REGISTERED OWNER giving their authorisation for you to sign the entry form on their behalf.

Public Liability It is a condition of entry that appropriate insurance forms be completed and signed by all those people who will either handle (including grooms), ride or drive a horse whilst at the show. Wristbands will be issued to those who sign forms and **NO** handler/rider/driver will be allowed entry to a ring without wearing a wristband. **ALL** handlers/riders/drivers must complete and sign the "AHSA Liability Declaration" form whilst those requiring \$10 public liability coverage for the show must complete and sign the "Registered Participant Application" form and pay the Non Member Participant's fee of \$10.00 with their entries.

Shakers Shakers will not be permitted at this show.

Use of Buggies at SIEC Anyone driving golf carts or buggies during the show at SIEC, must sign a waiver with SIEC Management staff and be issued a wristband **BEFORE** they can drive such vehicles. All drivers must be licensed drivers and adhere to public road rules where applicable. No golf cart and/or buggy can be driven after dusk without headlights. No intoxicated persons can drive golf carts and/or buggies. As the roads through SIEC are public roads, the Police will be randomly patrolling these roads during our event.

COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE: UNLESS PAYMENT ACCOMPANIES A SIGNED ENTRY FORM, ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

IF A STAMPED SELF ADDRESSED ENVELOPE IS **NOT** INCLUDED WITH ENTRIES, YOU WILL **NOT** RECEIVE EXHIBITOR NOTES CONFIRMING YOUR ENTRIES OR STABLING/CAMPING, OR A TIMETABLE.
